This school started as a day care center with 10 children in the year 1995 in a church hall. The school began to grow and a building was built for the school in 2007. The standard of the school also increased and it became a very acclaimed English Medium school in the town. There are now 175 children in the school. The school has grades from 3 years of Kinder Garden, 1st through 5th grades. It has the approval of the government for running the classes. The government recommended fees is collected from them.

There are about 40 children who are from very poor sections of the society whose parents are in the category of daily laborers, painters, house maids, drivers and some of them don't get regular income. So it is difficult to manage the expenses of the school when they can't pay the school fees at all. As a result the school gets into debt as they need to pay the teachers and the staff.

The school Correspondent Margaret says it would be helpful, if they could receive a support of Rs.35000 a month, which will help the school in its running without the hiccups of paying the staff on time.
