Preparation for the Camp: The IPA Faith City church and its volunteers spent two weeks of time to let the people know about the camp. Handbill, billboard, rally announcement, notices along newspaper, information to other churches were done to advertise the camp.

THE GREAT MEDICAL CAMP DAY

People started streaming into the camp as early as 9 AM. Youth team of IPA, Kovaipudur assisted them to meet the concerned doctors in a queue.

People from villages like Sundakamuthur, Ramachetipalayam, Arivozhi nagar, Kulathupalayam & Kovaipudur made use of the camp. People with Blood Pressure, diabetics, joint pain, dental problems and various illnesses took part and checkedup their health. Those who had problem with their vision were tested and given medicine. All the medicines were given free of cost for both eyes & general health. Spectacles were provided to the needy at very low cost. People flowed to camp till 3 PM and the doctors attended to everyone who had come for checkup.

The Service

Around 20 who needed operation for better vision were taken to Moses Gnanabaranam hospital at Coimbatore. Food, transport, accommodation were given free of cost and they were again dropped at the same venue a day later after successful operation. Those who underwent operation were from poor family background that they cannot spend money for operation. They felt great about the free service provided and left happy with improved vision.
